But at the start, all you need is a warm smile and a soft, open energy that says, "You're safe here."

Give him that grace for ten seconds.

With that in mind, let's dive into the next part.

Let's talk about where, when, and how to meet the kind of men you actually want in your life.

Chapter 1: Where to Meet

Meeting new people can be hard. If it were easy, we wouldn't have countless apps and platforms built just to make it easier.

These apps work for some. For others, not so much.

So, let's talk about the options available for meeting men.

There are two main ways: **Online or Offline.**

First, the online route.

Tinder, Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, and LinkedIn have birthed thousands of relationships — many leading to marriage.

And many more will start and flourish there.

If you don't have profiles on these platforms yet, now is the time.

If you do, but you're not getting the kind of attention you want, it's time to switch things up.

Ask yourself:

- What does your "About Me" say?
- Do you actually reply to DMs?
- Have you ever slid into a man's DM? (We'll cover this fully later.)
- How smooth are your conversations online?

Also, have you heard of matchmaking services hosted on social platforms?

Some have real success stories. Give them a shot.

Now, let's talk **Offline**.

Successful men are not hiding on another planet.

They drive the same roads.

Shop at the same malls.

Fly from the same airports.

You might not cross paths every day, but trust me, they are around.

That said, some places make it easier to meet them than others.

- **Gyms:**

Men who value their health hit the gym, early morning, after work, or weekends.

They're not gym rats or bodybuilders.

They're just busy men who want to stay fit.

Tip: Choose gyms located in neighborhoods where the kind of men you're looking for would feel at home.

- **Airports:**

If you want men with high-paying jobs or successful businesses, airports are gold mines. You can meet them during flight delays, at lounges, in queues, or even in-flight.

Simple conversation starters:

"Are you heading home?"

"What book are you reading?" (Airports are full of readers.)

- **Bars and Clubs:**

Contrary to popular belief, not every man at a bar is a one-night-stand hunter.

Many good, hardworking men unwind there too.

Yes, you might meet a few players, but you might also meet someone special.

- **Yoga Classes:**

Yoga isn't just stretching, it's a whole culture of mindfulness, balance, and healing. And poor men don't practice mindfulness. Only successful men do. So joining a studio class (not a private one) is a good option. And before you join, ask about the male-to-female ratio before signing up.

- **Running Clubs:**

Joggers are part of an unspoken "tribe."

They greet each other even if they've never met.

A shy lady can shine here, just by showing up regularly.

- **Churches:**

If you want a God-fearing, tongue-speaking, vision-seeing man, church is a great hunting ground.

Singles programs, meet-and-greets, and prayer sessions for singles can open doors.

- **Co-work Spaces:**

Coworking hubs are filled with upwardly mobile freelancers, entrepreneurs, and remote workers. These guys are rich or at least doing well because most of them have high paying jobs (either in naira or dollars). Hanging out at a co-work space is a smart idea.

- **Group Trips and Picnics:**

Join travel and picnic groups.

Ask questions before booking: Are they mostly singles?

Most group trips organize fun activities that make mingling easy.

Chapter 2: Different Types of Men

When it comes to dating, I've seen things.

One time, I thought I had met *the one*. Fine boy. Sweet talker. Took me on dates. Said all the right things. His friends were already calling me "wifey." Until one day, small argument like this, and he said, "You should be grateful I even chose you."

Chapter 3: How to Meet Men (Without Looking Desperate)

Finding a man you like sometimes feels like running a marathon barefoot. You need patience. You need positivity. And you need even more patience. But let me tell you, there is a thin line between being patient and wasting your time.

I will show you how to stand on the winning side.

Here is how to make your patience sweet and fruitful without making it look like you are hunting for a man.

- **Go Out Alone or With Only 1 Friend**

Men are not as bold as you think o.

Many of them are shy. They are battling fear. Their heart is beating fast like drum. Even the ones that look confident are usually scared inside.

Now imagine you are sitting with five loud friends.

My sister, you have made his work ten times harder.

He is not only thinking about you. He is thinking about your whole committee.

But when you are alone, or with just one friend, you look more approachable.

You look like someone he can greet and talk to without shame.

Also, when you are relaxed and happy, a good man will notice you.

He will feel safer to approach because even if you say no, it will not feel like disgrace.

But when you are inside a big group, even if he likes you, fear will hold him back. If you must go out with friends, know when to walk away small and give destiny space to meet you.

- **Make Eye Contact**

If you want to be noticed, use your eyes.

When you are out and you see a man you like, do not just look away shyly. Catch his eye. Hold the gaze for one or two seconds. Then look away and smile.

You have just passed a big message without opening your mouth.

When you lock eyes with a man you like, you are telling him "You can come and talk to me."

You are opening the door for him. Simple eye contact can be the beginning of something sweet.

- **Appear Unoccupied**

When you are out, stop looking busy even when you are not. Drop the phone. Drop the laptop. Drop the magazine. No need to scroll Instagram from morning till night. A man will see you glued to your phone and think, "She is busy. Let me not disturb her."

Even if you are bored, pretend you are not. Sit and sip your coffee. Look around. Smile.

Phone down. Ear open. Face open.

- **Smile (And Mean It)**

Many women say, "I looked at him. I liked him. Why didn't he come?"

They do not know if you are waiting for your husband.

So they will just admire you from afar and leave you alone. But you can invite them closer with just one small thing. Smile.

Not the type of smile you give a random person on the road.

It gives him courage to start a conversation.

It makes him feel like he will not get embarrassed if he comes to say hello.

A simple, real smile can change everything.

- **Become More Visible**

Do not go to a party and hide in the darkest corner like thief.

Sit where people can see you.

Near the door. Near the bar. Somewhere there is movement.

If you hide, how will destiny find you?

Also, help men by giving them something easy to talk about.

Wear something interesting. Maybe a nice bag. A bold necklace. A beautiful scarf.

It is easier for a man to say "I like your bag" than to say "I find you attractive."

Give them small chance to talk.

It can lead to bigger things.

Attracting committed, rich men is not about chasing. It is about putting yourself where you can be seen. Looking available. Looking happy. Smiling. Being open.

The man that wants to love you and invest in you will find you. And from there, it will not just end in boyfriend and girlfriend. It will lead to a beautiful, serious relationship and finally, marriage.

Chapter 4: The Initial Approach

Let me tell you a little story.

A few years ago, I was at a wedding in Edo state. I noticed a tall, handsome guy standing by the drink table. He wasn't doing much, just sipping his drink and scrolling through his phone.

The old me would have admired him from afar, hoping he'd notice me, maybe accidentally bump into me, and spark a conversation like in the movies. But something in me snapped that day. I thought, *"Why am I waiting? If I like him, I should at least give us a chance to meet."*

So, I walked up to him, complimented his shoes (they were pretty nice, to be fair), and just like that, we got talking. He ended up asking for my number.

Moral of the story? I made the first move but he chased me after that.

Now, this chapter and the next are for 3 categories of women:

- **Category 1:** Women who are tired of waiting. Tired of waiting for men to notice them, approach them, and decide if they're worthy of love.
- **Category 2:** Women who live life on their own terms. Women who are bold enough to choose the man they want instead of leaving it to chance.
- **Category 3:** Women who feel like they're on the verge of getting desperate, not fitting fully into the first or second category but open to learning and changing.

Let's face it: there's no rulebook that says only men can make the first move.

In most parts of the world, though, women have been conditioned to believe otherwise. It's almost taboo for a woman to walk up to a man she fancies. So even if she likes him, if he doesn't make a move, nothing happens.

This way of thinking puts women at a huge disadvantage.

It gives men all the power — to choose, to reject, to decide.

And if the men who approach a woman don't fit her standards, she's left with two choices: reject and stay single, or settle out of frustration.

This should not be the case. It's time we turn the tables. It's time women sat in the driver's seat of their love lives. It's time only men who meet *your* standards — in looks, ambition, values, income bracket, whatever matters to you — get the privilege of chasing you.

Note: I said *let them chase you*. Not the other way around.

You were probably thinking you'd have to do all the chasing, right? Nope.

You don't have to chase. You only have to initiate with class and feminine subtlety, then take your foot off the gas and watch him prove his interest.

From my experience, it's *much* better to **attract** a man than to **chase** him.

Chasing scares men off. It also makes you seem desperate, and men can smell desperation from a mile away.

Your goal is simply to **get his attention**. Once you do that, the ball is in his court.

Now, I won't lie to you, making the first move can feel scary.

Your heart will pound. Your palms will sweat. You might even freeze up.

But guess what? Men feel that fear too when they approach women!
So when you make the first move, you're actually doing him a huge favor. You're saving him the stress, the nerves, the overthinking.

If he's a good man, he'll be grateful you made it easier for him.
He'll admire your confidence, because confident women are unforgettable.

Now, making the first move won't ever be *easy*, but it gets easier with practice.

This chapter is here to give you practical, easy steps you can start using **today** to overcome shyness, kick fear to the curb, and start attracting the kind of men you truly want.

Let's dive right in.

- **Overcoming Fear and Shyness**

The first thing you must do is throw away the lie that says a man must be the first to approach.

After that, face the two enemies: fear and shyness. Your heart will race. Your palms will sweat. You will feel silly. It is normal. Everyone feels like that at first. The good news?

There are two simple ways to kill the fear.

First, practice starting conversations. Second, reframe rejection.

The whole essence of approaching him is to create a moment that allows the both of you to talk and maybe exchange contact cards. If you are a good conversation starter, approaching him will be less difficult for you. If you're not, stay glued to the next few pages. They will help a great deal.

- **Talk to Strangers**

You meet strangers every day. Start talking to them.

Set a personal target. Talk to at least two new people every week. It could be at the supermarket, in a taxi, at work, anywhere. Talk about anything: traffic, music, football, the price of garri, politics, crazy landlords.

You start the conversation. You don't wait. The more you practice, the easier it becomes.

And if anyone ignores you? Their loss. You're a princess, so keep moving.

The more you normalize talking to people, the easier it becomes to talk to any man you find attractive.

- **Practice With Men Paid to Talk to You**

Yes, you heard me. There are men whose job is to be polite to you. You still don't want to consider it? My dear, these are regular guys meet them at airports, gyms, hotels, bars, malls, restaurants. They wear uniforms. They smile at you. They open doors for you. I'm talking about: Flight attendants, gym instructors,

Male ushers, bouncers, bartenders, waiters, petrol attendants.

Use them for practice. Start harmless conversations with them.

Flirt if you like. The goal is simple. Practice confidence.

Nothing more. No strings attached.

Remember, mastery comes from practice.

Nothing in life is hard. It's just unfamiliar.

- **Fear of Rejection**

Rejection sucks. In work. In life. In love. But rejection is not the end of the world. Most men will not even reject you. Do you know why? Because they hardly ever get approached by women. You might be the first woman ever to walk up to him. Even if he is married. Even if he is not in a good mood. Even if you are not his type. He will still respect your boldness.

Confidence is sexy. Confidence is magnetic. Confidence makes men want you more.

So keep practicing. Keep getting better. Very soon, you will be able to sweep any man you fancy off his feet.

Fear? Fear will pack its load and leave.

Hre are Some Conversation Starters

Let's start with some killer conversation openers. They are great for opening a conversation with someone new or someone you haven't seen in a while. And they're far more interesting than the standard "Where are you from?" and "what do you do?" See for yourself:

How is your week/weekend going?

This one is nice and simple but can open a conversation in a lot of different directions—perhaps they've had a weekend stuck in the office working, or they've had an amazing week of sales. It's important to give them some information to reply to, too.

Do you have a ___? Me too! Tell me more.

Anything you have that is similar to the person you are interested in is a great conversation starter online or offline. We like people like us. This is known as the similarity-attraction effect. Fill in the blank with your similarity, and then ask for more details.

What three words best describe you?

Find out how they view themselves and don't forget to ask follow-up questions about each of the words they chose.

What would be your perfect weekend?

See what they are into, and you'll have plenty to talk about. Everyone loves talking about things they love.

What's your favorite way to waste time?

Similar to the perfect weekend question, this question tries to get at what they really enjoy doing so that you can both talk about it.

What do you think about religion?

Do you have any? If they don't, there is probably a story behind it. Africans are a religious bunch. If they do have one, you can talk about where they worship, where they celebrate the popular religious festivities, etc.

What were you really into when you were a kid?

Every kid goes through phases when they were REALLY into one thing. For many, it was street soccer. You can ask about the position they usually play, why they didn't pursue a professional football career, etc. For others, it can be video games, music, books, etc. Now you can find out what they obsessed about when they were a kid.

If you could have any animal as a pet, what animal would you choose?

This one is fun because a blank check pet choice can lead to some great answers. And you can always transition the conversation into pets they had/have.

If you are to open a business, what kind of business would it be?

This one can really be a huge conversation starter if the person you are talking to is in any way entrepreneurial. It's always fun to hear and discuss new business ideas. Don't forget to ask for lots of details about their dream business.

Who is your favorite entertainer (comedian, musician, actor, etc.)?

Pop culture and entertainment are great topics for conversation, and this question is a good entry point into a larger conversation about what kind of entertainment they like.

What is a controversial opinion you have?

So, don't immediately start bashing their opinion if you don't like it. I mean, you asked the question after all. Let them explain why they have the opinion and their reasoning behind it. Not everyone has to have the same opinions as you. And if it's super out there or evil, well it's good to know so you can avoid them in the future.

Who had the biggest impact on the person you have become?

An awesome question for keeping it positive, and they'll be talking about someone they love, so it'll be easy to jump into a conversation about whoever that person is and why they are so awesome.

What is the most annoying habit someone can have? Find out what annoys them, chances are it probably annoys you too. Then it's easy to step into a conversation about annoying habits.

If you had to change your name, what would your new name be?

This one is a little creative and fun. They might have to think about it for a bit, or they may have an answer right off. Don't forget to ask them why and what might be a good last name as well.

Where is the most beautiful place you have been?

This one will probably lead to a good travel story. And conversations about travel are always fun.

Where do you spend most of your free time/day?

Find out what their day-to-day looks like. It'll be easy to start up a conversation about any of the things they do on a regular.

What's the funniest TV series you have seen?

This will work best if he is a movie lover and is perfect for starting a conversation about a show you both are into, and if you haven't watched the show they mention, you now have a new show to check out!

If you don't feel comfortable asking personal questions right out of the gate, use your environment and surroundings to start the conversation. Comment on the food and drinks. Ask about the venue or location. You also can ask general interest questions, such as their favorite sports team. It works!!!

Chapter 5: How to Approach Men Like a Badass

The first time I approached a man, I was terrified. That was in the Edo wedding I told you about in the previous chapter.

Do you still remember?

Okay.

Here's the part I didn't tell you. That "moment" I gathered the courage to complement the fine rich man, I felt like I was about to jump off a cliff. My palms were sweaty, my heart was pounding, and my mind was screaming, "What if he ignores you? What if you embarrass yourself?"

But I did it anyway. I smiled, walked up to him, and said, "Hi."

He smiled back and said, "Hey."

That simple exchange changed everything for me.

It taught me a powerful lesson: Approaching a man instantly reveals what kind of man he is.

If he's kind, open, and receptive, you'll know. If he's rude, dismissive, or arrogant, you'll know too. And either way, you win.

One word — "Hi" — can save you weeks, months, or even years of wasted time and heartbreak.

Now, let's talk about the several ways to approach men.

Here are 6 of the most common ones.

You can choose one, practice all of them, and pick your favorite:

1. The Bump-and-Flatter Approach

"Accidentally" bump into him at a party, mall, or café. Laugh it off and say,
"Oh, sorry – I'm usually clumsy around fine people."

Instantly, he'll feel flattered. You're already close to him physically — easy gateway for a conversation.

Bonus: Most men don't get daily compliments. He'll enjoy the attention. If he's interested, he'll take it from there.

2. The Compliment Approach

Simple. Say something nice. His scent. His shoes. His beard. His energy.

Example:

"Wow, you smell really good."

"Nice watch. Very clean."

Compliments unlock flirty conversations effortlessly.

Because real talk? Guys *crave* compliments more than they admit.

They just don't get them often.

3. The AHAQ Approach (Ask Him Any Question)

Need an opener? Ask a casual question:

- "Is this seat taken?"
- "Are you the last person on this queue?"

- “Please, do you know where XYZ Street is?”

When you ask a guy a question, **you create a door** for conversation. And trust me — once the door is open, it's easier to walk through.

From one innocent question, a full-blown romance can sprout. (Ask your parents.)

4. The Direct Approach

This one is for my confident babes. No tricks. No games. No handkerchiefs. You simply walk up to him, smile, and say what's on your mind.

"Hey, I'm Tonye. I like your vibe. Want to grab a coffee?"

Or if you want to spice it up:

"Hi. I like you. Would you like to be a man and ask me out?" (With a playful smile, of course.)

Real recognize real. Men admire women who *own their desires* and make bold moves. Be direct. Be sweet. Be unforgettable.

Side note: this is how one of my friends (Chidinma) got her husband. It happened at a lounge at Ikoyi, he was frustrated with client calls that evening, and she went to him and approached him. But I don't know for you, Chidinma has a lot of “mind”.

5. The AHFH Approach (Ask Him For Help)

“I could really use your help with something...”

MAGIC WORDS.

When you say this to a man, you tap into his primal need to be needed. It doesn't even have to be a big deal. It could be:

- "Can you help me carry this drink?"
"Can you hold my jacket for a second?"

Once he helps you, conversation becomes *natural*. No pressure. No awkwardness. Just human connection. If he's into you, he'll take the chance to keep talking. If not, you lose nothing.

6. The White Handkerchief Approach

Old-school but GOLD.

In Victorian times, women weren't allowed to make the first move. So what did they do? They'd "accidentally" drop a handkerchief while walking past a man.

Of course, the man would pick it up, return it — and boom — a conversation starts.

And guess what? *The woman orchestrated the whole thing.*

Today, you don't have to carry a handkerchief.

But you can still "drop" opportunities:

- Drop your phone (gently abeg!)
- Drop your napkin
- Or simply hover around in a way that invites him to approach

Give a man an excuse to speak to you. Most of them are just dying for an opening.

Bottom Line? Approaching a man isn't hard. It's smart.

It's brave. And it puts you in charge of your love life. Forget waiting around for fate.

Sometimes, **you are fate**. One "Hi" could change everything.

Chapter 6: When Men Get Intimidated

I remember my friend Funmi.

At 36, she walked down the aisle with the love of her life, after years of battling the stigma of being a successful, single woman.

Funmi had a great job, owned her own home, and traveled whenever she pleased. Yet, each birthday, the questions grew louder. Family members, friends, even colleagues, all asking when she would "settle down," as if her life wasn't already full.

Finding love wasn't easy for her. Not because she wasn't beautiful or lovable. But because the higher she rose in life, the harder it seemed to meet a man who wasn't intimidated by her.

It felt like the more she had going for her, the more men fell away.

But she didn't give up or shrink herself. Instead, she made a mindset shift, one that led her to her husband today.

I'm sharing Funmi's story because you need to know: **your situation is not unique, it's not your fault, and it's definitely not spiritual.**

Yes, it's true especially in the society we live in.

Once women cross certain ages, they are often faced with the social stigma of being single.

This, on its own, can be mortifying. But it gets worse once you hit a certain income level.

You seemingly start repelling men. You find it hard to meet dates. The men in your circle are mostly colleagues, business partners, brothers, relatives — or toyboys.

This explains why many high-achieving women struggle to match their career success with success in their romantic lives.

They know exactly how to negotiate a deal or ace a boardroom meeting, but when it comes to love, it feels like an uphill battle.

If you find yourself here, you might wonder:

Should I lower my standards? Date younger men? Give up?

1. Understand: Your Situation Is Not Spiritual

The stigma can be nauseating.

It can eat away at your self-esteem, make you question yourself, or even wonder if you're cursed.

I may not be able to tell you if you have flaws or not — we all do — but I can tell you for free: **your situation is not spiritual.**

Don't go hopping from one religious house to another, begging for deliverance.

Nothing is wrong with you. You are perfectly fine.

And you are definitely not alone. Millions of women across Nigeria, Ghana, Kenya, and beyond face the same struggle.

It's society's sickness to look down on single women, not yours to carry.

Don't internalize it.

2. Treat Getting a Man Like a Game and a Job Search

We hustle for the jobs we want. We research, network, prepare. We know it takes effort.

But when it comes to love, many leave it to chance. At your level, you already know: There are two types of people — those who make things happen, and those who wait for things to happen to them.

You've waited long enough. Where has it gotten you? It's time to change the strategy. Treat finding a partner like you're on a mission — somewhere between a strategic job search and a fun game. Be intentional. Have fun. Don't be too serious, but don't treat it like a joke either.

And if you haven't already, **revisit Chapters 1, 3, 4, and 5** — where I shared practical steps on how to get his attention, how to make him come to you, and how to build magnetic attraction.

3. Shift Your Mindset

If you think you're single because of your education, your career, or your age — **think again.**

Your accomplishments are *assets*, not *liabilities*.

Here are some statistics to back it up:

- A 2005 article in the *American Journal of Sociology* found that **women in positions of power are sexier to men** than women in less powerful roles.
- **71% of high-achieving men** said a woman's career success makes her **more desirable** as a wife.

- **92% of successful men** say they are more attracted to women who are successful too.
- **89% of high-achieving men** want to marry a woman as intelligent (or more intelligent) than they are.
- **68% of single, successful men** say they want a woman as committed to her career as they are.

Now, let's look at why some men ghost so you can recognize the signs early and position yourself properly.

Chapter 12: 4 Rules to Avoid Dead-End Relationships

There are a lot of dead ends in life.

Dead-end roads.

Dead-end jobs.

And maybe the most painful of all... “dead-end relationships”.

A dead-end relationship will waste your time, your emotions, your energy, and worst of all, it will waste your life.

Especially if what you really want is a rich, serious man who knows where he's going, and wants you to go there with him.

Wasting years with someone who doesn't even know what he wants? God forbid bad thing!

Let's talk about the simple rules that will help you *avoid* time-wasters, and stay open for the kind of man that will actually *add* to your life. Not drain it.

The problem is either you don't know the signs, or you see the signs and play blind.

But either way, you must learn them, recognize them, and act fast.

I broke down 15 major signs later in this book. Study them like your life depends on it. Because in a way, it does.

Rule 2: Thou Shall Not Date Without a Clear Purpose

You are not 18 anymore, my sister.

You don't have time to be "vibing" with men that have no plan.

From the first date, you must gauge his seriousness, not by what he says (anybody can talk), but by how he moves.

- Does he sound like a man preparing for a real future?
- Does he have a stable source of income?
- Is he financially responsible?
- Does he live like a man who is ready to lead and build?

You're not asking these questions because you're desperate — no.

You're asking because you're valuable and your time is precious.

A rich, serious man respects a woman who knows what she wants.

He won't be scared by your standards — he'll be impressed.

Rule 3: Thou Shall Not Date a Married Man

This one is simple: Married men are not available.

Their life is already built around someone else.

Their money, their emotions, their time — it's all tied up somewhere else.
