Chapter 1: The Ingredients You Need

You only need two(2) ingredients for this vjay tightening ritual:

1. Bagaruwa (Hausa) OR esoboni (Yoruba) OR Acacia seed (English)



2. Cloves



You'll find these ingredients in every market. Just ask.

Chapter 2: The Vjay Tightening Ritual - Step-by-Step

Wash the ingredients properly

Take 1 cup of Bagaruwa seeds and 1 cup of cloves.

Put both in a clean bowl of water and wash thoroughly to remove dirt or debris.



✓ **Boil the mixture**

Now, pour the washed seeds and cloves into a clean pot.

Add enough water to cover them well.

Boil on medium-low heat until the colour changes — it should look **brown** like Lipton tea.



✓ Let it cool then filter and sieve

Once it's boiled, turn off the heat and allow the mixture to cool down. Then use a clean sieve to filter out the seeds. Pour the liquid into a clean container with a cover — something you can use daily.



How to Use:

- Use this mixture to wash the entrance of your vjay twice a day
- Do this **3–4 times a week only**
- After washing, take your normal bath and rinse well
- Once you feel your desired tightness, **stop using it**

 **Important:**

- DO **NOT** use this every day
- DO **NOT** consume this mixture — it has some serious side effects
- If you're **pregnant**, **avoid** it completely
- If you've **not given birth before**, DO **NOT** drink it — it can affect fertility. Only use it for **steaming**.

Alternatively, you can wash your vjay with this mixture and also steam your vjay with it. You can do both OR do either. Depends on how convenient it is for you.

For Steaming:

Want to steam instead? Or do both? Here's how:

- Pour some of the steamed mixture into a large bowl.
- Make sure the mixture is **hot but manageable** (not warm — we need the steam)
- Sit over the bowl so the steam rises toward your vjay
- Wrap a big cloth or wrapper around your waist down to trap the heat
- Sit for **10–15 minutes**, until it cools



💡 **Do this 3 times a week** if steaming only.

If you're doing both wash and steam, limit steaming to once a week.

Make sense?

⚠️ **Quick Note on Drinking Bagaruwa or the Mixture (For Those Who've Heard About It)**

Now, let's talk about something important...

Some women swear by **drinking** Bagaruwa.

They say it works for internal cleansing, tightening from the inside, and even managing certain feminine health issues.

But before you rush off to boil and drink, please read this carefully.

If You Must Drink It, Here's What You Need to Know:

1. It must be taken in VERY small quantity.

Yes — **very small**. I'm talking just **1 or 2 sticks max**. Bagaruwa is very potent, and too much of it can do more harm than good.

2. Don't drink it on an empty stomach.

Make sure you've eaten before taking it. This helps reduce any side effects like nausea or discomfort.

3. Only once or twice a week.

No daily drinking here. Limit it to once or twice a week — and that's only if your body handles it well.

My Honest Take?

I personally don't take it.

The one time I tried drinking it... I vomited. 😫 My stomach just couldn't handle it.

But I know a few women who take it with no issues— so I guess it depends on your body. We all react differently.

Very Important Distinction:

The **dosage for steaming/washing** is different from the **dosage for drinking**.

- For **washing or steaming**, you can use **plenty Bagaruwa** — no problem.
- But for **drinking**, just **1–2 sticks only**. Please don't get it mixed up.

Are we clear?

Okay then — let's move to the next chapter. You're doing well  

Chapter 3: How To Know When the Ritual is Working

Okay sis, so how do you know this thing is working?

Simple. No long story.

Once a week, after you shower, **gently dip your middle finger inside your Vjay.**

No need to go too deep o. Just enough to feel the inside walls.

Now, if you've been consistent with the ritual (whether you're steaming or washing), you'll feel the difference.

VERY Important:

Once you've reached a level of tightness you're happy with... **stop using it.**
No need to overdo it.

Else pastor will find it hard to enter Jerusalem gate.

Chapter 4: What to Avoid

Quick Warnings You Must Never Ignore

As you already know, too much of anything is bad.

Even too much water can cause wahala, talk less of a mixture this powerful.
So please **use it exactly as I explained in the last chapter.**

And just to be clear, here are some **important things to keep in mind:**

 **Do NOT use it every day.**

This is not ordinary. The herbs are strong and work like fire. 3 - 4 times a week is enough.

 **Do NOT drink the mixture.**

It can cause serious side effects if taken carelessly. (If you still want to drink it, scroll back to the earlier chapter where I explained how to do it safely.)

 **Do NOT use it if you're pregnant.**

Abeg, wait until after delivery.

 **If you've never given birth before, don't drink it.**

It may affect your ability to conceive. Instead, **stick to steaming** — it's safer for you.

 **Do NOT use the mixture when you're on your period.**

Let your body finish its natural cleansing. You can resume afterward.

Chapter 5: How to Stay Tight Even After Your Next Baby

If it works for your first baby, it can work for your next baby and the baby after that.

Don't wait till it's bad before you act

Start your tightening ritual 6–8 weeks after delivery (after your doctor clears you). Don't wait till you feel "loose" — prevention is better.

Be intentional about what you eat

Some foods help nourish the muscles inside and keep you naturally firm:

- **Okro soup** – Rich in mucilage, helps keep things naturally juicy and supple
- **Avocados** – High in healthy fats and Vitamin E for skin and muscle elasticity
- **Dates (Dabino)** – Known to strengthen the uterus and aid postpartum recovery
- **Tiger nuts** – Improves libido and moisture
- **Water** – Stay hydrated. Tightness is harder if your body is dry inside

Bonus Guide: Extra Tips for Staying Fresh & Sweet All Day

Staying fresh and sweet down there isn't rocket science — it just takes a few intentional habits. Here's what every woman should know:

1. Change your undies daily

Sounds basic, but you'll be surprised. Cotton pants are your best friend. They allow air in and reduce odour-causing moisture.

2. Wash with only warm water

Avoid soaps or perfumed washes inside your vjay. They mess up your pH and can make you smell off. Warm water is enough — your body is self-cleaning.

3. Sleep without pants

Let your vjay breathe at night. This helps reduce sweat and prevents bacteria build-up that causes odour.

4. Eat these as often as you can:

- **Pineapple** – Helps your body smell and taste sweeter
- **Greek yoghurt** – Balances bacteria and improves vaginal health
- **Cucumber & watermelon** – Flush out toxins and keep you hydrated
- **Fenugreek seeds (methi)** – Known to make you smell fresh from within

5. Stay away from:

- Tight nylon underwear
- Sitting too long in wet clothes (like after gym or bath)
- Sugary drinks in excess (they throw off your pH)

Remember, smelling fresh is not about sprays or wipes — it starts from the inside. Eat right, stay dry, and stay clean — you'll notice the difference.
